

Year 7 Catch up Funding Statement 2018-2019

The Government provides every secondary school in the country with additional funding to support the progress of pupils entering school who achieve below the national average score of 100 in English and Maths assessments at Key Stage 2. Schools are provided with financial support to try and help this group of pupils catch up with the national average.

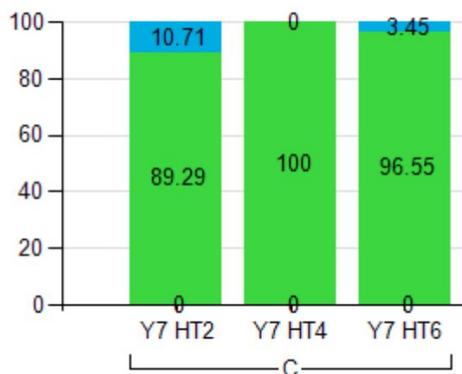
Last year PSCA received £12,315. This was spent on the following

Area of spending	Cost
0.2 teaching time was given to a member of the Maths team to focus on working with the cohort and support their learning.	£6000
Teaching and Learning support in the studio to support interventions in the studio	£6315

The impact of the spending was as follows for the cohort of 29 students who met the criteria for catch up funding (29/110 - (26% of the Year 7 cohort). Progress is measured against FFT top 10% predicted grades so all students are expected to be able to close the gap so they can achieve at least a pass at GCSE (Grade 4) in English and Maths at the end of Year 11 for their GCSE examinations.

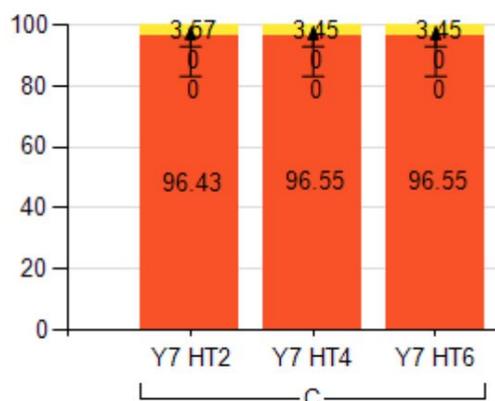
Maths

All 29 students are making expected progress but only 1 student in the cohort is making greater than expected progress (3 students in HT2 were making greater than expected progress)

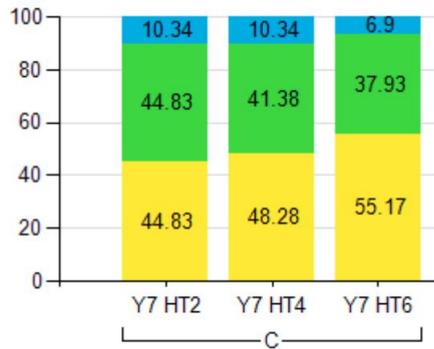
Overall Attainment



Only 1 student is just below age related expectations all the other 28 students are working below age related expectations. Progress is being made but this is not at a rate to close the gap with national.

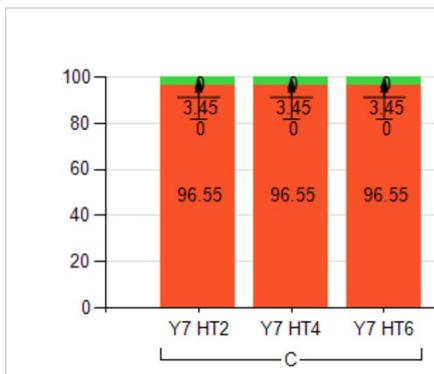
English

Over 50% of the cohort are not making the expected progress and this has increased across the year. 2 students are making greater than expected progress.
