How do students work remotely?

Checklist of expectations

Students need to make sure that they check their school email address at least twice a day (once in the morning and once in the afternoon). *This is important because we will be sending out important updates about learning or any relevant information.*

Your email will be your **initial letter of the first name, your surname** and **2 digit date of entry** then **@psca.co.uk**

Example **acarpenter19@psca.co.uk**

In English

Every student is expected to complete a minimum of two sessions per week using Bedrock
